## *Where's that from?*

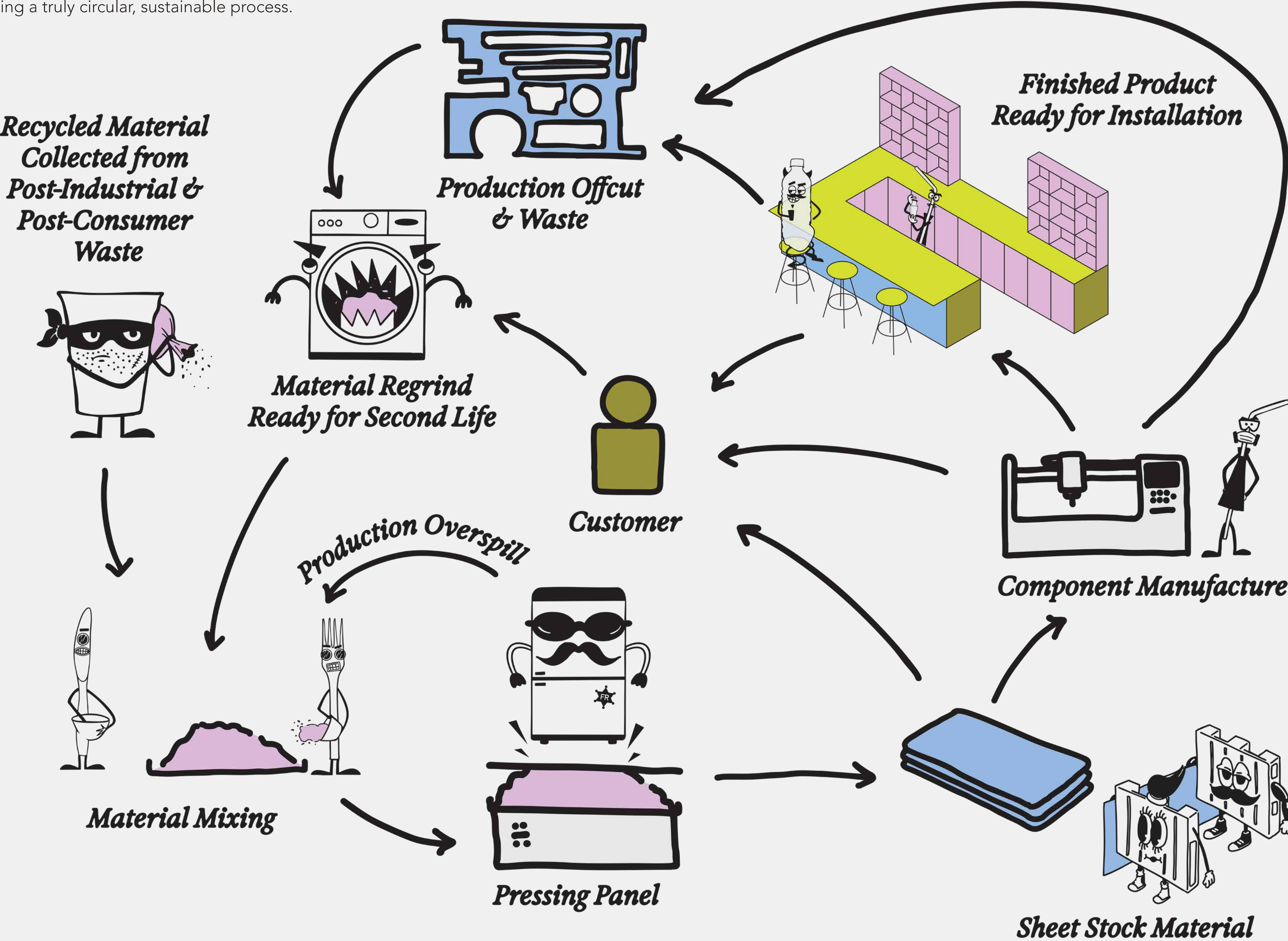
Our recycled plastic materials are sourced exclusively from UK waste streams, ensuring a truly local and transparent supply chain. We work in miles—not thousands of miles—to calculate our materials' journey, and in some cases we can even trace it in steps, from collection to processing. By sourcing locally, we maintain full visibility and control over where our materials come from, while significantly reducing transport emissions.

Each source undergoes rigorous due diligence to confirm material quality, consistency, and suitability, as well as compliance with environmental and ethical standards. This careful selection process allows us to recover the right plastics at the right point in the waste stream, diverting valuable resources away from landfill and reintroducing them into productive use within the UK circular economy.



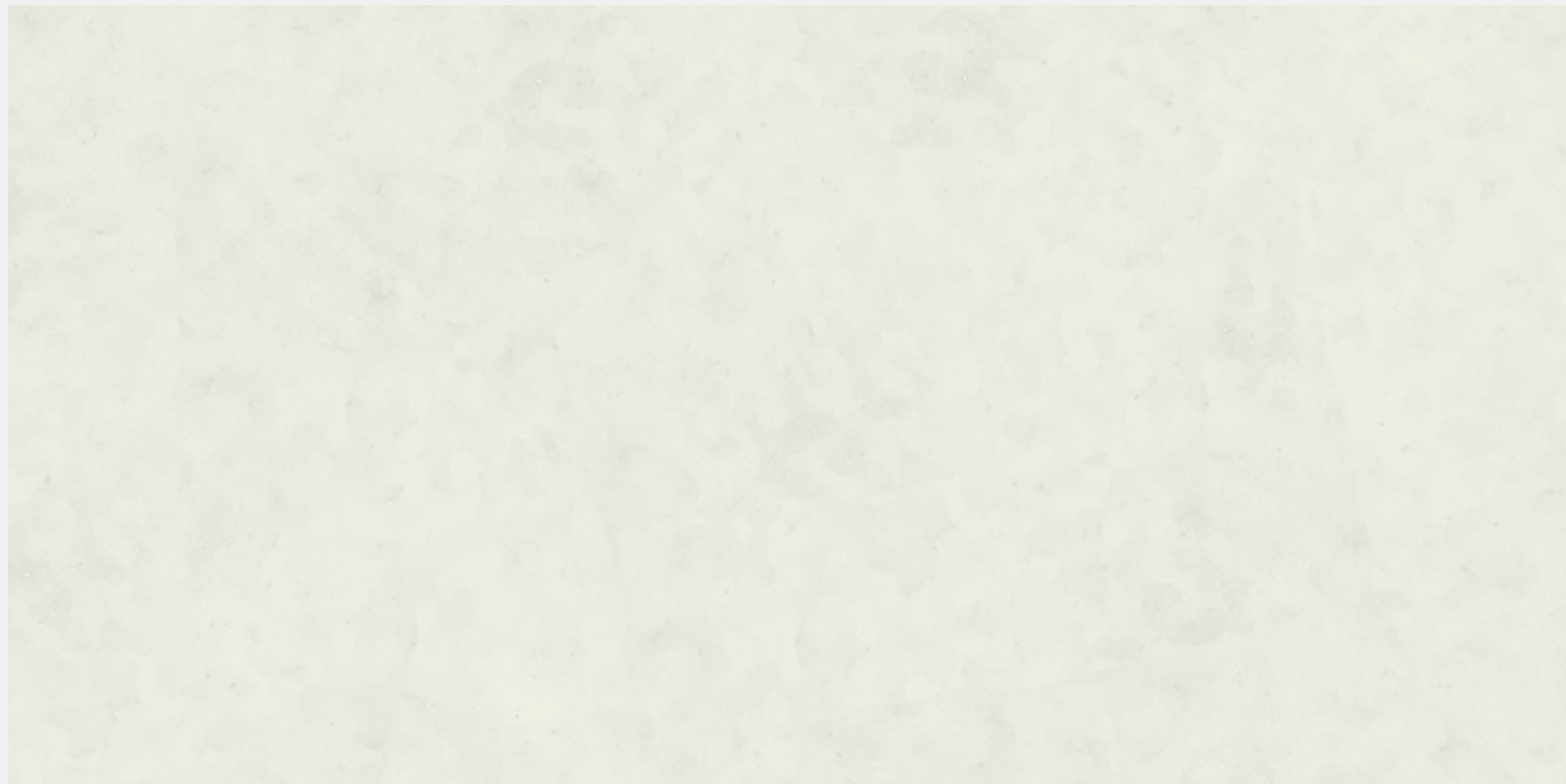
# What's the Story?

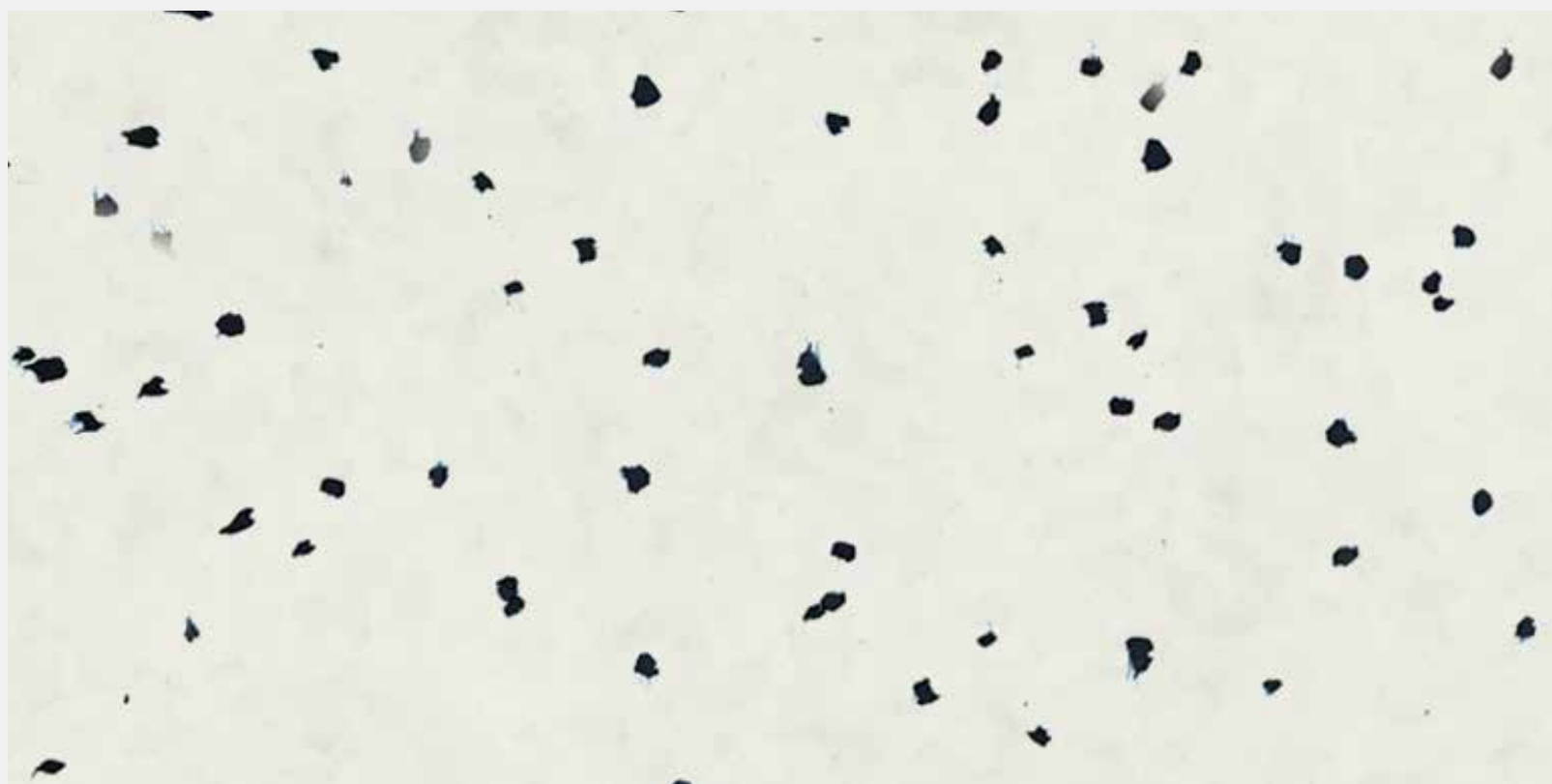

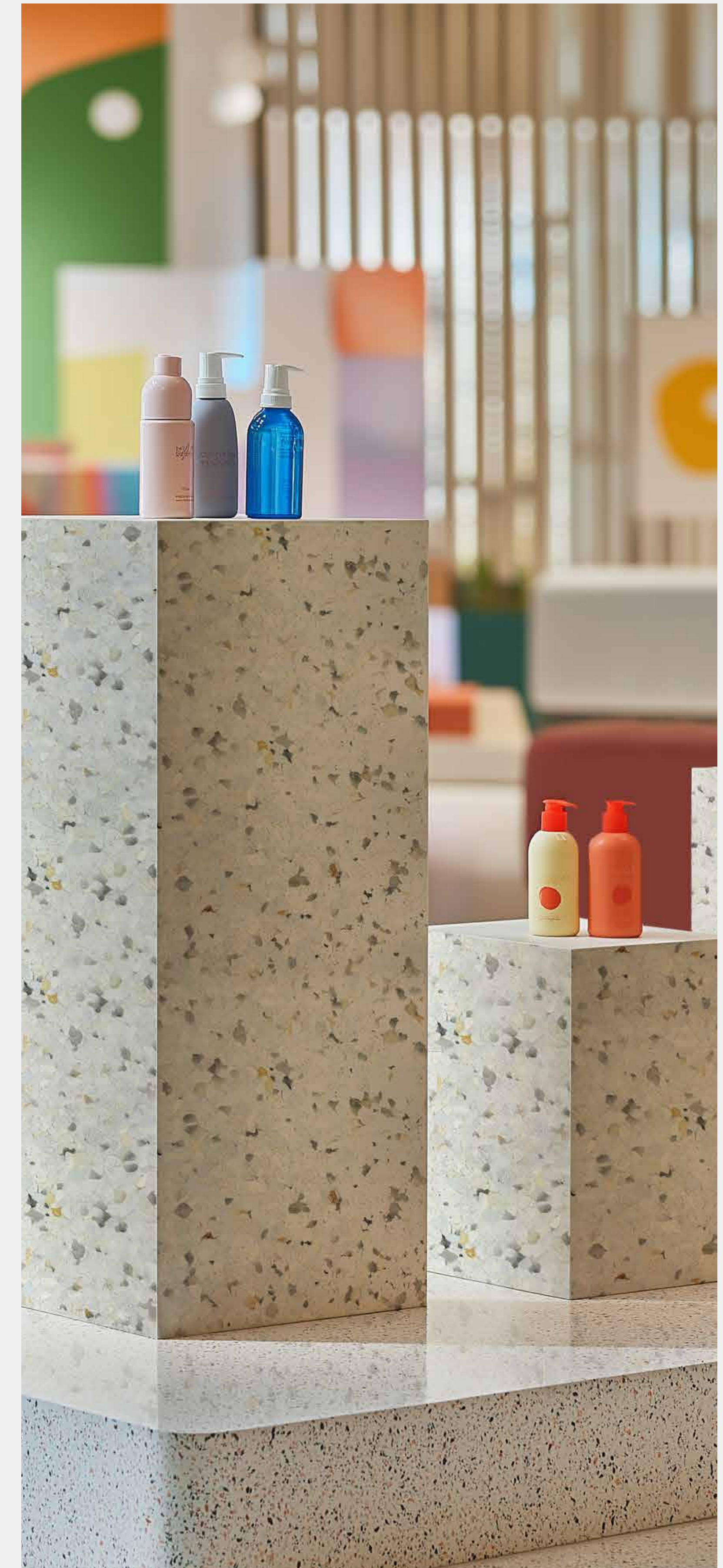

## *WHAT x JDD*

We collaborated with JDD, who visited our factory to design and develop their own unique material. Created using automotive parts, CNC shavings, edge banding, and white goods, the material was then processed by our team to produce a series of bespoke table tops and bench seats for their London showroom in Clerkenwell. This project was a great example of creative partnership — combining JDD's design vision with our technical expertise to transform unexpected materials into distinctive, high-quality pieces that celebrate both craftsmanship and innovation.



## *WHAT x Coventry University*

We were proud to collaborate with Coventry University's Product Design Degree Show to create a series of bespoke awards inspired by traditional loom punch cards. The pieces were crafted from automotive parts and CNC shavings, paying homage to Coventry's rich automotive heritage. Each slab featured etched detailing and a distinctive stone-like finish, merging industrial materials with refined craftsmanship to celebrate innovation, creativity, and local history.



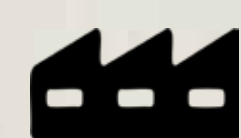
## *WHAT x Boss Design*

We recently partnered with Boss Design to create a series of plaques celebrating their latest acquisition. This collaboration provided a great opportunity to explore our ongoing development work with polypropylene, combining dog food tubs, production regrind, and recycled Ola chairs from Boss Design's own waste stream. The result was a striking marbled material, rich in texture and character, which not only marked the occasion beautifully but also inspired the development of a new collection of products.
